Since 1972, Dr. Dale Herder, O.D., has been providing quality eye care for the Coffey County community. Dr. Herder moved his office to 225 Cross Street in late November 2006 to have a more visible and convenient location. Patients have commented on how bright and roomy the new location is compared to his previous location that was in a residential area of Burlington.

The quality and professional services offered by Dr. Herder, and his associates (all from Burlington): Julie Schneider, Optometric Technician; Sara Westman, Optician Assistant, and Karen Maley, Lab Technician, go beyond the basic eye exam.

With a wide range of frames to choose from in the expanded Frame Dispensary, you may choose frames or contact lenses to suit your taste and style. Children's frames are also available.

Services offered through Dr. Herder's office also includes contact lenses, foreign body removal, vision training, visually-related learning disability rehabilitation, and pediatric eye care.

Dr. Herder also works with children through a perceptual cognitive training program that focuses on retraining the brain to correctly interpret what the eye is seeing. Children who have trouble relating and interpreting visual cues that directly affect his/her ability to learn may be a candidate for this program. Dr. Herder was able to help several students at local elementary schools improve learning skills by up to four years in an intense, 18-week program.

Dr. Herder's office is open Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Saturday 9 a.m. to 12 noon, with evening appointments on Wednesdays only, and accepts most insurance. **Pat's Pig Bar-B-Que and Catering II, LLC**

You can smell it in the air...there's a great barbecue restaurant in town. And if you listen close enough, you might hear the band playing on the "Brew, Blues & BBQ" nights at Pat's Pig Bar-B-Que and Catering II.

Pat's Pig Bar-B-Que is a welcome addition to the Burlington area offering a unique flavor of good food and friendly service. Co-owners Christie and Jennifer Wingert have made-over the interior of the restaurant with blue and gold paint, stylish artwork, wall hangings, and plants. There are murals in the entrance and south hallways, currently in progress, that were designed and are being painted by the Burlington High School art students.

The three "seat yourself" dining areas include the banquet room, bar area, and north dining room. Access to seasonal patio for outdoor diners is through the banquet room. All indoor seating is non-smoking.

Pat's Pig Bar-B-Que offers a variety of menu items with appetizers, salads, combo and a la carte rib dinners, entrees, BBQ sandwiches, sides, as well as burgers, and a full-serve bar. Pat's serves

up the BBQ with their unique, homemade sauce in two "heats"; mild and hot.

Friday and Saturday nights, enjoy great BBQ and good blues music. A different band is featured each week and plays in the banquet room. Check with Pat's for bands and play times.

Pat's Pig Bar-B-Que Catering includes your choice of meats, sides, and drinks. Delivery is available for catered events of twenty or more or you can pick up your order. There is a fee for deliveries outside of Burlington.

The banquet room is available for rent and can seat up to 60 (up to 84 with additional seating in the bar area).

Pat's Pig "Buy" the Pound and "Buy" the Side offerings lets you entertain without the fuss. "Buy" the Pound options include BBQ beef, ham, turkey, pulled pork, sausage, burnt ends, and smoked chicken. All meat comes with one 6 oz. mild BBQ sauce container per pound of meat. Additional BBQ sauce can be purchased by the pint or quart. Sides include BBQ beans, potato salad, coleslaw, cottage cheese, green beans, and mashed potatoes in pints or quarts.

"Buy" the Pound and "Buy" the Side orders are packaged in either plastic containers or heavy-duty aluminum foil containers depending on the amount of the order. Pat's Pig will help you plan how much BBQ and sides you need for your get together.
